The Thrive Together induction package has been designed to help you, as the Thrive lead, to inspire your colleagues with how embedding the Thrive Approach can create happier, calmer children that are better engaged with their learning.

The induction package will help you to communicate the basic principles of Thrive to the wider staff in your setting. By working through the modules, it will help them to understand how to be and what to do in response to children's differing and sometimes challenging behaviour.

Offered as a series of individual modules, you have the flexibility of running five individual 1-1½ hour training sessions or amalgamating as a whole day session. The modules consist of:

- Live-action films covering a range of primary settings using Thrive in different ways, including interviews with children, parents, teaching assistants, teachers, senior leaders and governors.
- Animations to introduce Thrive theory and practice, including the developmental model and underpinning neuroscience, child development and attachment theory.
- Step-by-step session plans with check-in/check-out activities, discussion pointers and practical activities.

- Downloadable handouts.

After working through the induction package, your staff will have gained a fuller understanding of what the Thrive Approach is, how it works, the basic theories that underpin it and what they need to do in practical terms to embed Thrive in their practice.
