Using Thrive-Online to screen whole groups of teenagers will help you to identify their underlying emotional and social learning needs. The course equips academy/school staff, within their daily role (SLT to MTA), to enhance and maintain learning environments in which young people feel safe, supported, inspired and able to learn and succeed. As well as tools to use when things go wrong, you will learn how to use young people's behaviour as a clue to underlying developmental interruptions. As a result you will become more confident in your interactions with adolescents and able to reduce stress levels within relationships between staff and young people.
